Blind Golfers are required to become Ordinary Members of the WABGA and pay \$30 membership fee for 2016 / 17.

All Caddies and Supporters will automatically become Associate Members (as a minimum) when accepted into the WABGA.

Caddies and Supporters can also opt to pay the membership fee of \$10 and become Ordinary Members of the WABGA, Ordinary Members will be entitled to be invited to the WABGA AGM and be able to vote on WABGA matters including Committee Membership and changes to the Constitution. (Associate Members have no right to vote, but have all other rights provided to a Member under the Rules of the Constitution).

### **Golfers**

Please remember that for those who are interested - to be eligible to play in any sponsored International Blind Golf event such as the Australian Open, any of the eastern state championships or international events, you must have a current IBGA eyesight classification and handicap. The Secretary has a list of those with IBGA eyesight and handicaps.

### **Payment**

The cost of membership is \$30 for golfers and \$10 for Ordinary members for 2016/17. Membership renews on July 1<sup>st</sup> each year. Membership fees for part year (from January 1<sup>st</sup>) is \$15 for golfers and \$5 for Ordinary Members.
